



INTRODUCING REF

K-Devices announces the availability of a new device: **REF, the rad envelope follower**.

REF allows you to modulate anything you want in Ableton Live: other devices, the user interface, and third party plug-ins, using sound as source.

*You can **shape the incoming audio source** with the low/high pass filter, listening the source in **peak** or **rms** modes, then design the envelope exactly how you need it, using tools as **relative/absolute** modes, **linear/logarithmic** modulation, and **positive/negative** directions.*

*You can even work on your envelopes with standard **EG** parameters as **attack**, **hold**, **release**, and a global **delay** time.*

Developed on the **Max 6 engine**, taking advantage of **gen~**, REF supports both **32** and **64 bit** mode. **No external objects** are used in REF.
